Regulation 10 NYCRR 415.12 Quality of Care

(c) **Pressure sores.** Based on the comprehensive assessment of a resident, the facility shall **ensure** that:

- ❑ (1) a resident who *enters the facility without pressure sores* does not develop pressure sores unless the individual's clinical condition demonstrates that they were unavoidable *despite every reasonable effort to prevent them*; and
- ❑ (2) a *resident having pressure sores* receives necessary treatment and services to promote healing, prevent infection and prevent new sores from developing.

PRESSURE ULCERS

Pressure ulcers (also called bed sores) are a red-flag indicator of possible neglect: a facility must ensure that a resident admitted without pressure sores does not develop them unless unavoidable, and if sores do exist, the facility must provide timely treatment, preventive devices, proper nutrition, positioning, and incontinence care.
